



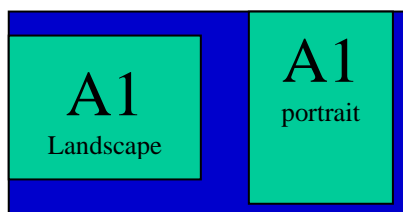

POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

Poster presentations are an ideal opportunity for those who are more comfortable with visual presentation methods to present preliminary work or display to complex findings. Poster presentations allow delegates more time to study and reflect on the work, often resulting in thought-provoking questions and comments.

Poster presenters will be provided with a space on a display board which will accommodate a poster of A1 size (594mm x 841mm), either portrait or landscape orientation.



You may display your poster, and any leaflets you have produced in advance, for the duration of the conference. The poster presentations will be in the NAB Foyer, which will also be a space for delegates to circulate and look at the posters during all refreshment and lunch breaks. In addition to this there is a dedicated poster session at the conference, where presenters will be invited to speak to conference delegates about your work and gain feedback. Your poster must be in place 45 minutes before this session.

You are responsible for displaying your poster and removing it after the conference. Posters should be secured to the display boards using Velcro strips (hooks).
