- Must be nominated by a current BSA member
- Must be a BSA member or join BSA at time of nomination
- Must have experience of being published in refereed journals
- Must have refereed a minimum of three articles for a peer-review journal
- Should not be members of the editorial board of more than one BSA journal at a time.

***Nominations are accepted from any area or specialism within sociology although we are seeking in particular nominations of people with experience of one or more of the following areas:***

- Stratification
- Comparative sociology
- Crime and deviance
- Religion
- Political sociology
- Ethnicity
- Employment, work and labour markets
- Family
- Transnationalism/migration
- Quantitative methods (survey analysis, basic statistical analysis, modeling)
- Social Theory

### **Please note:**

- The board welcome applications that reflect the full diversity of BSA membership.
- The editorial board meets twice a year in London.
- The BSA will reimburse editorial board members for all reasonable UK travel costs incurred as a direct result of their attendance at board meetings.
- Anyone living outside the UK who is interested in volunteering for the journal is advised to apply to the International Advisory Board.
- Former board members cannot reapply for membership until two years have passed since they last served on the board.
- We do not allow more than two board members from the same institution on the board at any one time. Please see information on current board members to the right.
