## Word limits

Submissions that are overlength will be returned to the sender for editing.

- Single book reviews: 300 words
- Study Group report:: 300 words
- Out of My...: 300 words
- One page articles: 750
- Feature articles (by prior agreement): 1500
- Desert Island Discourse: 1500
- Interviews: 2500 (Interviewers must provide an A4 size 300 dpi photograph of the interviewee).

## File formats

### Text files:

- should be prepared in Word or another standard word processing programme
- should include your name and institution at the bottom
- should **not** include any formatting

### Image files:

- should be 300 dpi minimum
- should be tiffs or jpegs
- should be accompanied by a caption and photographer credit
