HOW TO GET TO THE BRITISH LIBRARY CONFERENCE CENTRE

By Rail

Kings Cross, St. Pancras International and Euston rail stations are within walking distance of the British Library. Delegates arriving into other London rail stations are advised to use the London Underground and alight at any of the following stations: King's Cross/St. Pancras, Euston and Euston Square.

By Bus

Many London bus services stop on Midland Road and Euston Road. These include: 10, 30, 63, 73 and 91. There are a number of bus-stops in the area so please ensure that you contact **Transport for London** for further details, Tel: 0207 222 1234; web: www.tfl.gov.uk.

By Taxi and Car

Please consider the environment when planning to travel around London. Public transport links are extremely good and taxis can be an expensive and timely option.

Please also note that there is no public parking available at the British Library. There are car parks in Marchmont Street under the Brunswick Shopping Centre and an NCP in Judd Street. Metered parking (6 places) is available on Ossulston Street.
