

POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

In 2009 the Programme organisers launched a new poster presentation format with a dedicated slot in the conference programme where presenters were invited to speak to conference delegates about their work and gain feedback. This has proved to be very successful. A prize is awarded for the best poster, voted for by delegates at the conference. The Committee may also award a prize for the most innovative poster.

Poster presentations are an ideal opportunity for those who are more comfortable with visual presentation methods to present preliminary work or to display complex findings. Poster presentations allow delegates more time to study and reflect on the work, often resulting in thought-provoking questions and comments. The Committee also wish to encourage innovative methods of visual presentation which make good use of the available space to engage delegates with the work being presented.

Poster presenters will be provided with a space on a display board which will accommodate one poster of A1 size (594mm x 841mm), of landscape orientation. Posters not meeting size requirements will not be displayed.



Please display your poster, and any leaflets you have produced, as soon as you arrive at the conference. Posters **must** be in place 45 minutes before the dedicated poster session, and where possible they should remain on display for the duration of the conference. The poster presentations will be in the CAMS (Conference Aston Meeting Suites) exhibition space which will also be a space for delegates to circulate and look at the posters during all refreshment breaks.

You are responsible for displaying your poster and removing it after the conference. Posters should be secured to the display boards using Velcro strips (hooks). Places on display boards will be allocated by the Programme Organisers.
