Despite being a key aspect of postgraduate research, it can be an isolating experience with room for nuanced conversations on power, vulnerability and mixed emotions. Preparing to encounter these feelings and building a caring community can help while undertaking fieldwork. This Postgraduate Regional Event will be a relational, creative space to discuss personal experiences, find solutions to shared challenges, and generate support networks.
