Responsibilities include teaching three courses per year (typically two undergraduate and one graduate), supervising student research, and maintaining a rigorous, highly productive and externally-funded program of empirical research that maintains and builds the department's international reputation.

Qualifications: We seek scholars with an innovative research program and a commitment to outstanding teaching. Candidates must have a Ph.D. in Sociology at the time of appointment.
